The capacity expansion supports rising market demand and positions Sherwin-Williams for continued growth in Coil markets. It adds a new, modernized manufacturing wing to the space with advanced automation and increased production capacity designed to support the **22% increase** in demand we saw between 2022 and 2025. The expansion is designed to improve lead times, supply reliability and batch quality for our customers.

The modifications modernize production through computer-controlled batching, reducing manual processes and improving consistency. New tank systems increase the total plant capacity by **60%, a 33% increase** to total silicone-modified polyester/polyester capacity across all the plants. The facility operates at an optimal 80% capacity utilization and enables future growth for WeatherXL™ SMP and PolyPREMIER® Polyester product lines.
